Lindsey is a 15 year-old girl, who just 4 years ago was playing soccer and riding horses. She had no idea that her life was about to change forever.

At age 11, she was diagnosed with a type of bone cancer called Ewings Sarcoma. In October of 2006, she had limb salvage surgery to remove the tumor in her left leg, which showed that she was actually suffering from small cell Osteosarcoma instead of Ewings Sarcoma. After 21 rounds of chemotherapy, Lindsey’s cancer was gone.

A year from the day of her last chemotherapy treatment, she had a recurrence. The cancer was back. With her mother and father, she traveled to Houston for treatments and then New York City where she was forced to undergo a hip replacement. Upon coming home, a chest CT revealed that Lindsey had tumors in both of her lungs. After having nodules removed from her left lung, she was accepted into a study at the Hillman Cancer Center in Pittsburgh. She had her third thoracotomy, but it did not get all of the disease, which was continuing to progress. After being told by doctors that Lindsey was out of medical treatment options, she and her mother headed to the Philippines to try an experimental antibody-type treatment. The treatment was not working, so they returned home to Pittsburgh on January 14, 2010. Lindsey is now using naturopathic remedies to manage her disease. She is receiving hospice care, but she and her family are hoping for a miracle.

On March 27th the Hotspurs Soccer Organization will be holding a fundraiser benefit to raise money to help Lindsey and her family with the burden of their medical costs, travel expenses and future medications. We have organized a Bingo event, involving a Chinese Auction and raffles. If you are willing to make a donation (gift cards, monetary donations, prizes, etc.) to help make this event a success, and provide some relief for this very deserving family, it would be very much appreciated.
